Wheatfield and dominoes are both composed of an alignment of identical slender structures. For wheatfield, these structures stand in a stable state while for dominoes, the initial position is metastable. As expected, this difference plays a major role on the evolution of the system once perturbed and we try, in this seminar, to capture the main characteristics of the perturbed system.
