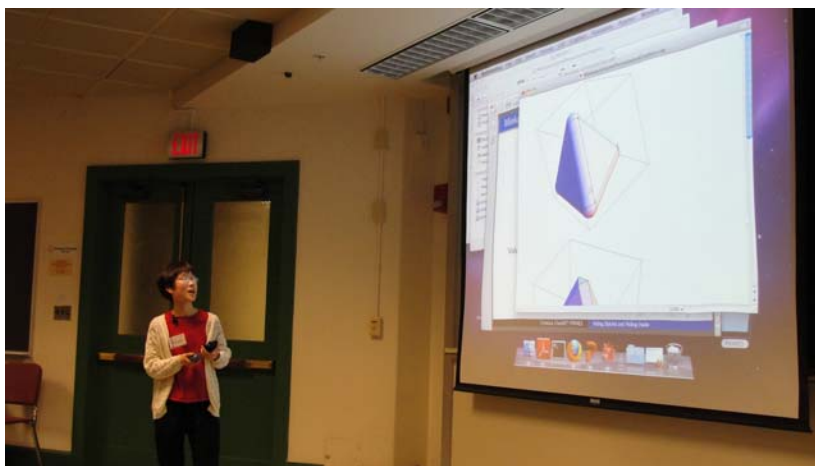

for high school students within commuting distance from MIT

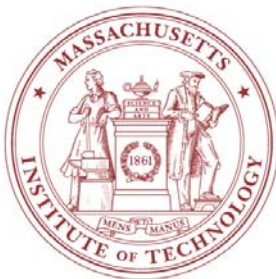


PRIMES student Christina Chen at the PRIMES conference at MIT in May 2011
